

KEEP AN EYE OUT!



November - December is peak fallout season for young 'Ua'u kani (Wedge-tailed Shearwaters). These birds are larger than the palm of your hand, with a tube-nose and webbed feet. Adults are sleek, but these youngsters may be found with varying amounts of "fluff" on them.

If you find a downed shearwater, please put it in a ventilated box and deliver to a dropoff location as soon as you can.
