Ensures Care follows Legal Requirements

The Hawai'i Wildlife Center is fully permitted by State and Federal agencies for the rehabilitation of all native bird species and the Hawaiian Hoary Bat throughout the State of Hawai'i.

The Hawai'i Wildlife Center Sponsorship program was created to formalize a collaborative relationship between HWC and entities that may encounter native wildlife throughout the course of operations. Clients entering into the Sponsorship program sign a support agreement, which provides for the medical and rehabilitative care of native birds and bats transferred from the Sponsor to HWC, an annual wildlife first response training course, and ongoing consultation if desired. Sponsors are also able to use HWC's name, facilities and reputation in any applicable wildlife conservation and response plans as well as for media and public relations purposes relevant to wildlife response. Costs of sponsorship depend on response needs and agreement term.
