

Interested in wildlife rehabilitation and veterinary medicine?

Hawai'i Wildlife Center is offering a unique shadowing opportunity to Hawai'i High School students to introduce native bird rehabilitation, the careers that are associated with this work, and the importance of these birds to Hawai'i. Students will get to follow wildlife staff and observe how patients are examined, taken care of, and rehabilitated.

Students will be assigned a 2.5 hour period from 9:30am to 12pm to shadow wildlife staff. This is strictly an observational experience and students will not be directly handling wildlife. Days are assigned to one student per day and on a first-come first-served basis.
